

COVID-19 Information

Update: 24/03/2020

Barossa Village continues to closely monitor developments in relation to the Coronavirus COVID-19. At this stage, none of our community is currently impacted through any infection.

We have established and resourced a Management Response Team to actively manage COVID-19 situation. The team is working through strategies and plans in line with advice from the Commonwealth Department of Health, and monitoring the Smart Traveller advice.

Please rest assured that we are continuing to monitor the situation on a daily basis, and are planning for any further escalation, should it be required. We will keep our community, residents and clients updated as the situation evolves.

Visitors

The Residency, Atze Parade, Nuriootpa:

- **Visitation to the Residency has been cancelled as of 25.3.20.**
- Families can leave personal items at Reception.
- For families with residents in palliative care, please contact staff.

The Lodge, Scholz Ave, Nuriootpa:

- Follow the advice as posted at entrances.
- **Stop and do not enter if:**
 - You are unwell with cold or flu like symptoms
 - You have had close contact with someone who has recently returned from interstate or overseas
 - You have recently returned from an overseas trip
 - You have had close contact with another person who has tested positive for the coronavirus COVID-19
- If you do not meet any of these entry restrictions, please observe the precautionary measures in line with our visitor entry requirements and government recommendations.
